You will be required to Lead the KS2 class in terms of teaching, learning and nurturing the children's personal development. You will have responsibility for managing the support staff within the class.

The successful candidate must:

- have a wide experience of identifying and meeting a range of Special Educational Needs;



- have extremely competent literacy and numeracy skills;
- have the highest expectations of pupil performance; and
- have a passion for finding out about how children learn and adapting their practice accordingly.
