Nursery places can be allocated and taken up at any point in the year, with the most common starting points being September, October, January, February, and April.

Nursery places are allocated in-house. Siblings of children attending the school already are given priority, and on a first come first served basis. A waiting list is maintained within the school, and places are usually allocated in April for the following academic year. A place in Nursery does not guarantee a place in Reception, as the admissions are undertaken by Northumberland County Council.
