Science

We will be working scientifically by asking questions, observing closely, performing tests, identifying and classifying, gathering and recording data, and suggesting answers to questions.

Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults

Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)

Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

We will be learning how to log on to the school internet and also onto school360 using our usernames and passwords. We will learn about personal information and how to keep it private when using the internet.

We will be developing familiarity and correct use of keyboard - spacebar, backspace, shift (for capital letters), return etc . We will be learning how to save our work and edit it.
