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Paper Lantern Collage

Supplies

- Wrapping paper
- A4 coloured paper
- Ribbon
- Glue
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Black felt tip pen
- Pencil



1 First, draw some shapes onto the back of the wrapping paper; you will need about four and these could be rectangles, triangles, hexagons or circles.



5 Then, put a little glue onto the back of each shape (at the top and bottom ends) and gently press onto the sheet of coloured paper. Leave to dry.



2 Then, carefully cut out each of the shapes.



6 Once dry, use a black felt tip pen to draw handles and tassels onto each lantern.



3 Next, fold the end of one of the shapes over and then turn it back over. Fold the paper backwards to create another fold and then turn over again. Repeat this process for the length of the paper to create a zigzag or concertina shape.



7 Finally, cut some small pieces of ribbon and stick a piece going vertically from the bottom of each lantern.



4 Fold the other shapes as in step 3 until all of your shapes are folded into zigzags.


