

Finger Paint Fireworks

Supplies

- A4 sized black or purple card
- Paint in a variety of colours
- Trays for the paint
- Glitter
- White pencil / crayon
- Glue



- 1 Place the card horizontally on a flat surface. Dip the tip of your finger into the paint and carefully place your finger onto the card. Drag your finger downwards, gradually putting less pressure on, before lifting it from the page.



- 2 Repeat step 1 until you have lots of different coloured fireworks towards the top of the page.



- 3 Now create some Catherine wheels towards the bottom of the page. To do this dip the tip of your finger into some paint, then swirl the paint around on the page.



- 4 Use a white pencil to add sticks for your Catherine wheels.



- 5 Finally, once the paint has dried, carefully paint small amounts of glue on the areas you want to have glitter. Tip a little glitter over the glue and wait a few minutes before tipping your card up to remove any excess glitter.
