Drop off/pick up procedure.

Thank you to all those parents who are adhering to the current drop off/pick up arrangements. In the main, it is working really well.

We would however, like to remind parents of the following points for the benefit of all our school community:

- Please ensure that you arrive at your specified time which you have been allocated
- Please do not turn around in the school/neighbouring houses gateways or on the road outside school as this causes a 'snarl up'. Please drive off in an easterly direction turning down the road at the side of Beaufront Castle. At the next junction, turn left for Corbridge or right for Anick/Hexham.
- Please ensure that you do not wait at the school gate. Come straight into the school yard at your allotted time to drop off/collect your child at the meeting point (wooden bench).
- Staff will only release your child when parents/carers are standing at the wooden bench.

As you are aware, in school we have been encouraging all the children to be vigilant with hand washing routines. You can help us by making sure that children practice at home.
