School Meals

From the start of this Autumn term the cost of a school lunch has increased to £2.90 for children in Class 2 and £2.40 for Nursery children. We have tried to keep the increase to a minimum but due to the rise in food and electricity prices we unfortunately have to do this. Payment for lunch up until half term will be on your School Gateway account next week. If your child currently receives free school meals, you do not need to do anything.

What: Creative winter-themed art activities for the children of Beaufront focusing on a variety of processes in 6 relaxed after school sessions - fun is compulsory!

We'll be building sculpture, working together in collaborative floor drawings, working on our resilience through self portraits and using recycled materials to create new exciting pieces of seasonal art in time for Christmas!
